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Zion Ministry opens first home for elderly, orphans in Imo state

Zion Prayer Movement Outreach recently demonstrated its commitment to the welfare of the vulnerable members of society with the opening of the first ever Old People's Home and Orphanage in Imo State.

The Seraphic Home, located in Mgbirichi, Ohaji Egbema, near Owerri, was commissioned by Imo State Governor, Senator Hope Uzodimma, who described it as a watershed in the provision of care for the elderly, needy and less privileged.

Uzodimma praised the Spiritual Director of Zion Ministry, Evangelist Chukwuebuka Obi, for “thinking home” and bringing meaningful development

to the state, adding that he was delighted with the choice of Imo State for such an impactful project.

According to the governor, “Evangelist Ebuka's decision to expand the ministry's operations in Imo has placed the state on a path to greater global recognition” —a vision he said he had foreseen when initially allocating land for the ministry's headquarters in Ngor Okpala.

Evangelist Ebuka Obi, in his welcome remarks, said that the home was built to provide care for orphans and the elderly, especially those without anyone to support them. He invited the elderly with no caregivers to take advantage of the facility, which offers

free accommodation and care.

“This state-of-the-art facility will provide a safe and nurturing environment for orphans and elderly individuals, offering them a sense of belonging and care. The home will provide shelter, food, clothing, education, and healthcare, and ensure that the residents receive the support they need to thrive,” Evangelist Ebuka disclosed. He said that the home would provide comprehensive care for old people and orphans free of charge, adding that more of such projects would be cited in other parts of the country.

The Seraphic Orphanage and Home for the Elderly will be a safe space for

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Zion Legal team Visits Kirikiri correctional centre

...Offers legal aids, gift items to inmates

The Zion Legal Team (ZLT) in January this year, led by the Admins and the Prison Committee, carried out impactful outreach at Kirikiri Correctional Center, Lagos ministering to the male and female inmates.

The visit was marked by profound moments of evangelism, intercessory prayers, and legal clinics.

The team provided essential spiritual and material support including copies of the Holy Bible, Effective prayer books and special programme booklets, and holy Rosaries.

Other essential supplies and food items given to them include

350 packs of jollof rice with chicken bags of 50kg. Rice and Garri, cartons of Indomie noodles, soft drinks, beverages, sanitary towels, toiletries, toothpastes as well as soaps.

The ZLT engaged in robust interactions with the inmates, listening intently to their grievances and reviewing their legal challenges.

Several cases currently in courts were adopted by the team, with legal proceedings already in motion to secure justice

and expedite their freed.

VOICE OF ZION notes that in the last few years, the ZLT has successfully facilitated the release of over 20 inmates by paying the fees associated with their offences.

At present, many cases are on-going in various courts across the country, with the team committed to pursuing justice for the oppressed for free.

Its core mission includes the protection and defence of the rights of citizens, especially the poor and oppressed in the society, particularly the Zionites.

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vulnerable populations to receive care and support, just as it will provide opportunities for community engagement and volunteerism and serve as a platform for skills development and capacity building for caregivers and staff, Evangelist Ebuka added.

Zion Ministry's Seraphic Home foundation is a non-profit charitable organization with the objective of touching and impacting lives positively and promoting the welfare of others. It runs a whole range of programmes which support disadvantaged and impoverished families by providing scholarships for different levels of Education for over 60 children yearly as well as funding for

patients who are unable to afford life-sustaining treatment and pay hospital bills for various health challenges.

The establishment of the Orphanage and Elderly People's Home is expected to have a significant impact on the local economy by creating jobs for locals in various capacities, including caregivers, administrators, and maintenance staff.

It will also stimulate economic growth by injecting funds into the local economy through procurement of goods and services, as well as attract visitors and potential investors to the state, thus showcasing Imo State's commitment to social welfare and community development.



18 Zionites get N1.8m for surrendering their charms

The Spiritual Director of Zion Prayer Movement Outreach (ZPMO), Evangelist Ebuka Obi, recently doled out N1.8 million to 18 zionites who embraced Jesus Christ and submitted their charms for destruction.

Evangelist Ebuka, who praised the Zionites for forsaking the devil, advised them to henceforth live righteous lives, pray to God for the forgiveness of their sins and embrace salvation.

According to him, charms are given to gullible people by occultic agents such as herbalists and "Eze Nwanyis" to extort money from them and push them into eternal destruction.

He, therefore, advised them to stop patronizing such agents of darkness as they do not have any good to offer to them.

"If you have more of such evil items at home, please go home and bring them to Zion ministry for destruction as they are powerless", the Evangelist added.

He continued, "once you submit them here and we destroy them and pray for you, just go home and continue to serve God Almighty as their powers won't affect you negatively".

The Evangelist said that idol worship breeds other ills such as ritual killings, kidnapping, and robbery as those behind them are the ones empowering the perpetrators of such ills with satanic powers from different altars.

"There is no hidden place for those evil doers and such evil practices must stop especially in Igbo land for genuine development to take place in our communities," Evangelist Ebuka stated.

According to him, the doors of Zion ministry are open every Sunday,

Tuesday and Wednesday for those with all kinds of charms or "juju" to surrender them, adding that the spiritual exercise will continue without end.

In another development, the Spiritual Director, enjoined Zionites, especially youths, to have a vision of what they want to be in life or achieve within a particular time frame and follow their dreams responsibly to succeed in life.

Speaking at a Sunday service in Lagos, he advised them to have big dreams, work hard, maintain good relationship with God and remain focused in order to achieve success against odds.

Evangelist Ebuka stated that anybody with vision is bound to go places especially if he or she holds on to God and avoids sexual immorality.

According to him, dreams come with challenges which, with God and persistent prayers, can be surmounted.

He explained that ZION ministry is part of the big dream he had some years ago when he was shown a vision where he was preaching to a mammoth crowd in an unknown place, adding that ZPMO has gradually become a global prayer ministry prayer.

Based on practical experience, Evangelist Obi advised Zionites "to be smart in a positive way, be strategic, versatile and ensure you do not settle for less in life". He, therefore, advised Zionites who want to succeed in life to, amongst others, learn skills beyond their paper certificates, especially given the stark reality of Nigerian economy which now lays emphasis on what one can do beyond what was studied in higher institutions.

Evang. Chukwuebuka Obi, the enigma !

It was in early part of year 2000 that the announcement crackled down from the pulpit at the Catholic Church in Aguda, Lagos, where I usually attended masses. It came tumbling down thus: "There is one young man in Okota, Lagos, who has opened a prayer house claiming to be a Catholic. Members are strictly warned from attending such a centre as the Archbishop of Lagos has not sanctioned it!"

After listening to it, I said to myself: "That one concerns those people who jump from one prayer house to another. What I know is Catholic Church and any day I feel tired, I will go home and carry my father's f?".

Actually, I am not the type that jumps from one church to another and each time I attempted, I always discovered one evil practice or another and I would bounce back to my traditional church.

Well, my life got stormy after I had risen to a certain height and I came crashing down. From being an importer of goods, I became an importer of sorrow and tears to the extent that I begged for garri!

It was in one of such rounds of begging that one of my old school boys who, after assisting me with the little he had, introduced me to Zion ministry. I had wanted to dismiss it with a wave of the hand, but he persisted. What struck me was his narrative: "My brother, I have been in your situation, but after visiting Zion ministry, things changed for better for me"! His testimony convinced me, and I collected the address from him. That was very early in 2022.

On the appointed day, which was a Wednesday, I first got to the Zion Ministry's ground and called my friend to know where he was. He told me that he was yet to come and when he did, we met at a point and he

graciously bought me a prayer book and Seraphic oil.

I had come with a view to discovering one of those "abracadabras" common to most of the so-called miracle workers and so, I positioned myself strategically.

If you ask me, the Almighty comes down to Zion ministry ground, using His chosen one, Evang. Chukwuebuka Obi to demonstrate His power.

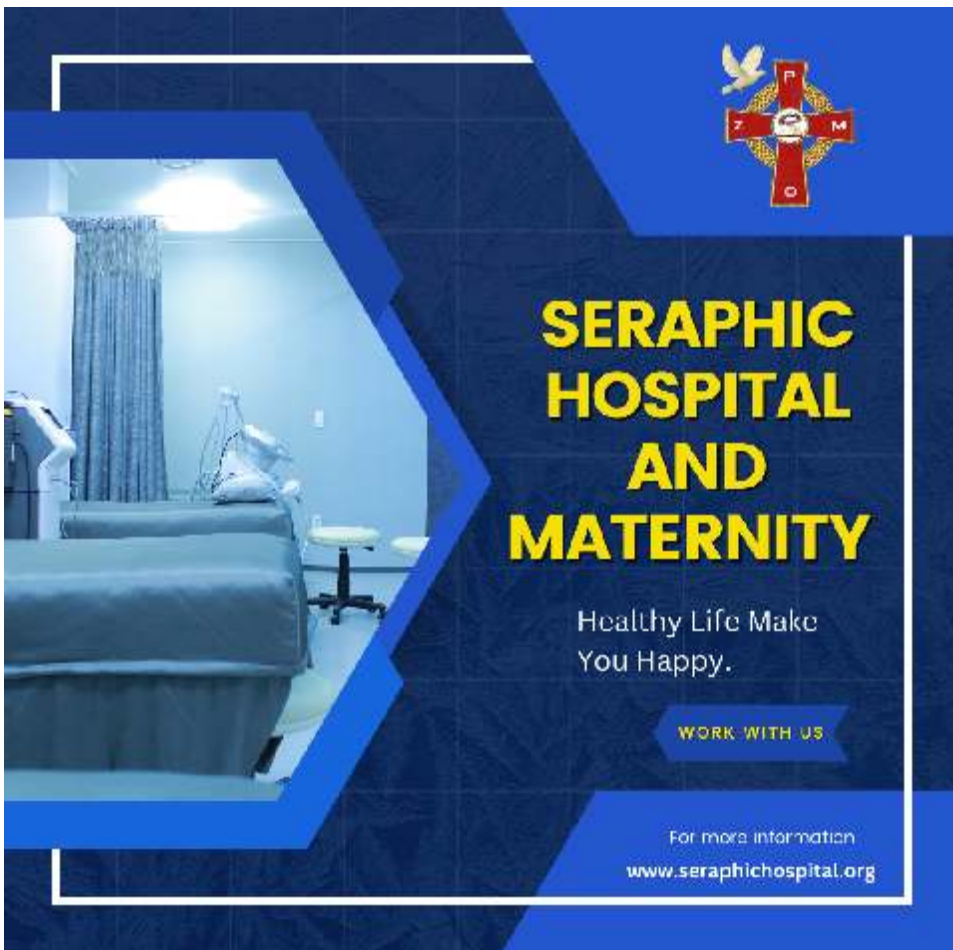
But we have a saying in my place that: "Oshi ag?g?, b? lere mm?w?" (Let doubters come and behold Masquerade)!

Personal consultation with Daddy resumes

Personal consultations with the Spiritual Director of Zion ministry, Evangelist Ebuka Anozie Obi, have officially resumed.

This was announced by the prophet recently owing to the growing number of people travelling from different parts of the world to Lagos, Nigeria, to seek the face of God through counsel and to know what the Holy Spirit is saying about them.

The consultation is not done virtually but physically at the Zion Administrative Building, Lagos.

Two days have been set aside for this - Monday and Friday. Evangelist Ebuka explained that Mondays are strictly for foreigners and Nigerians who reside outside the country. If they desire to

see the prophet, they are expected to come down to Zion Ground and register at the Receivers' team. Their passports and travel documents will be checked for confirmation.

On the other hand, Fridays are for Zionites in Nigeria, but they need to belong to any of the groups or branches to be eligible for the consultation. The scheduling will be coordinated by the leaders of the groups in collaboration with the admins of various Zion branches.

As the Prophet always says, once he is in the prophetic mood, you don't have to say anything; all you need to do is open your hands and ears and you will be told what the Holy Spirit reveals about you or your situation.

A Lecturer in the Federal University, Lokoja, Nigeria, Dr Njideka Ojukwu, recently testified of multiple promotions and divine favour, following her spiritual connection to the grace of Zion Prayer Movement Outreach.

Anglican Priest receives instant healing

A South African Anglican Priest in charge of Saint Saviour Church, East London, was among those who instantly received healing at the South African crusade.

The priest testified at the crusade ground that for years he was unable to hear with his left ear. According to him, the medical challenge that defied orthodox medication was spiritually cured when Evangelist Ebuka was praying and calling on the wounds of Jesus Christ for healing upon those with

According to the husband, Caleb, an Engineer who owns an electrical shop in Enugu, after his marriage to his wife, they had a son, contrary to a girl he had wanted in keeping with the record of his siblings. Not long after, his protracted business setback led to the closure of his shop, and he resorted to patronizing occultic altars for solution to his economic hardship.

He confessed at the HOLY GHOST COURT in Lagos that he reunited with his former girlfriend along the line and got her pregnant.

On the other hand, the wife, unknown to the husband, started having affairs outside, to cushion the biting economic hardship.

She later got displeased with her sinful lifestyle and confessed to her husband and asked for mercy and forgiveness.

The husband initially forgave her, and later moved his family to a smaller apartment, while still keeping secret his relationship with his pregnant girlfriend. According to him, when he reported the wife's infidelity to his father and siblings, they described it as unforgivable

Even though the couple were willing to reconcile, they were held back from doing so because of the opposition from the man's family.

He also advised the man to take responsibility for the upkeep of the pregnant lover and be ready to accept the baby. The Evangelist also counseled him to end the relationship with his lover as she was not a legal wife.

The South African crusade, the first of its kind to be held outside Nigeria by Zion Prayer Movement Outreach (ZPMO) attracted an unprecedented multitude of people from all over the world.

Zionites from different countries and continents converged on Expo Centre, NASREC, Johannesburg in South Africa to participate in the religious event which was held on March 29 and 30, 2025.

The Spiritual Director of ZPMO, Evangelist Ebuka Obi, attended the crusade with over 30 workers from Nigeria who were sponsored on the trip as a show of love and to ensure a successful outing.

His arrival at the Oliver Tambo International Airport turned into a carnival as the South African Admins and hundreds of Zion branch members enthusiastically came out in numbers to welcome the evangelist who was beautifully dressed in a Zulu attire, made up of animal skin and feathers.

Expectedly, the crowd surged forward, as many who could not believe that the Man of God was there in flesh and blood, tried to touch him.

The large number of people and ecstasy of the crowd disrupted the normal order at the airport for some time. He was then ushered out of the airport to a location where he addressed tons of Zionites who were unwilling to leave until he prayed and ministered to them.

To the best of my knowledge, this is an isolated case among the multiples of outstanding testimonies featured on the ministry's platforms.

The Zion Prayer Movement Outreach has become a great brand renowned nationwide and in the international community. The active members are in millions and there are branches in almost all

nations of the world. To my mind, such a ministry has grown beyond the need for orchestrated testimonies. The law of large numbers alone ensures there are too many quality testimonies to feature, without the need for any shenanigans. The real challenge is screening out the best.

Under the leadership of the highly anointed Evangelist Ebuka Obi, the Zion Ministry has zero-tolerance for immorality, unbridled quest for wealth, obscenity, fraud, idolatry, demonic consultations and all forms of vices. Evangelist Ebuka Obi's crusade style of puritanism has earned him open confrontation with native doctors especially of Eastern confraternities.
