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Zion Ministry's second International Crusade shakes Dublin, Ireland!

Zion Prayer Movement Outreach (ZPMO) held its second International Revival Crusade in the vibrant city of Dublin, Ireland, on July 26 and 27, 2025. Who Really Wants to Kill Evangelist Ebuka Obi?

Who is really after this man of God?

This is not a question you just brush aside, nor one to sweep under the carpet of religious politics or spiritual apathy. No. This is not a social media speculation or a mischievous rumour ignited by gossip mongers.

I've heard from Evangelist Ebuka Obi before about plans to kill him. Perhaps, you have, too. But many of us dismissed it the way Nigerians dismiss certain prophecies—especially when they concern leaders or public figures: with skepticism. A little prayer and we move on. After all, spiritual leaders are always under attack, right? Wrong. Not like this.

Recently, I saw a man burdened beyond the normal load of a prophetic call. His voice shook—not from theatrical emotion, but from a deeper place. His eyes, usually afire with spiritual clarity and boldness, seemed to carry a storm of pain and concern. This was not the voice of a man exaggerating for dramatic effect. This was the cry of a man who knows the danger closing in on him like shadows at twilight.

Evangelist Ebuka Obi is not your regular preacher. He is not the kind of man that comes and goes in the fleeting pages of religious sensationalism. He has built a spiritual movement that cannot be ignored. And therein lies the problem. Zion Ministry is no longer a dot on the map; it is now a flame—burning bright enough to light up many dark places and, by consequence, exposing many things that festered in silence. Such light often attracts insects, but worse still, it draws the anger of those who prefer the cover of darkness.

Let's not pretend we haven't noticed the growing drama surrounding Evangelist Ebuka Obi. It has become too loud to ignore. From vocal critics within the Church to passive-aggressive jabs from those who should know better, a storm is brewing—and it's not coming from outsiders. These attacks are not from the usual suspects—atheists, traditionalists, or even rival Pentecostal ministries. No. The arrows are coming from within his own backyard: men in cassocks and collars; voices from within the same Church that raised him.

The criticisms of Evangelist Ebuka Obi are apparently not righteous correction but something more bitter. Many of the critics have, repeatedly, allowed words that sound more like venom than virtue and to flow from their pulpits. These men may not openly declare war, but the signs are clear: there's a coordinated smear campaign brewing, cloaked under the guise of spiritual concern.

Why? Why would fellow labourers in God's vineyard choose to turn their pruning hooks into spears aimed at their brother?

Some say it's doctrinal. Others insist it's envy. But as a watcher on the wall, I say: it is deeper. It is a crisis of relevance, of pride, of identity, and of power.

Evangelist Ebuka Obi represents something that many traditional clerics cannot explain. He remains rooted in his Catholic faith, yet he walks in prophetic dimensions that have more in common with Pentecostal expression than with liturgical restraint. He preaches like fire, yet bows before the Eucharist. He blesses sacramentals with holy reverence, yet calls down miracles like Elijah. This duality—Catholic yet charismatic—has thrown many off balance.

To them, he is either a rebel or a threat. To

the spiritually blind, he is dangerous. To those consumed by ecclesiastical pride, he is unacceptable. But to those who are spiritually sensitive, he is simply a man whom God is using in an unconventional way for a generation drowning in confusion and sin.

Still, the hatred persists. And let us not be naive—it is hatred, not concern. It is not correction that drives these attacks; it is corrosion from within. The Catholic Church is not without its history of suppressing anything or anyone who breaks the mold. Even the saints of old—Padre Pio, St. John of the Cross, and many more—faced persecution from within before they were canonized as saints. Why? Because the institution fears what it cannot control.

Evangelist Ebuka Obi is not just building a congregation; he is building a movement. Zion is not just a place—it has become a spiritual destination for those who are tired of dead religion and empty ceremonies. In a country riddled with insecurity, poverty, and hopelessness, he has become a beacon of hope for thousands. That kind of influence cannot go unnoticed, nor uncontested.

Miracles happen at Zion. People testify daily of healings, breakthroughs, and divine encounters. And while some may argue that not all miracles prove authenticity, what cannot be denied is the consistency of lives changed. When those miracles begin to draw crowds larger than traditional parishes, the red flags go up. Some clergy now feel their pews are emptying, not because of scandal or poor preaching, but because people are hungry for something deeper, and they're finding it in Zion.

That's when jealousy takes root. That's when backdoor meetings start happening. That's when veiled threats are issued. That's when anonymous letters are written. That's when sermons begin to subtly attack rather than uplift. And slowly but surely, the campaign intensifies—not necessarily to kill the man with bullets, but to assassinate his character, to question his source, to cast a shadow on his light.

But who truly wants him dead?

Is it the priests who feel outshone? The theologians who believe he has broken the codes of doctrinal orthodoxy? The bishops who feel slighted by his independence? Or is it more sinister—hidden hands, ancient altars, and demonic agents who see him as a threat to their kingdom?

Let's be honest: when you start pulling people out of darkness, you offend the lords of darkness. When you start cancelling ancestral covenants, you frustrate those who profit from generational bondage. When you call out hypocrisy in high places, you paint a target on your back. Evangelist Ebuka Obi has done all these—and more.

And yet, through it all, he stands firm. He does not run. He does not renounce. He does not retaliate. He keeps preaching. He keeps praying. He keeps prophesying. He keeps loving. That is the true mark of a servant of God—faithfulness in the midst of fire.

But how long before the fire turns into an inferno?

I worry. Because in this country, character assassination is usually the first step. Then comes the physical attack. Then silence. And then, the crocodile tears and empty tributes. We've seen it too many times. From politicians to pastors, prophets to activists—anyone who dares rise too high, too fast, without the blessing of the "gatekeepers," is often pulled down.

So, who really wants to kill Evangelist Ebuka Obi?

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First free Psychiatric hospital to open in Anambra state

Seraphic Homes Foundation and Zion Prayer Movement Outreach (ZPMO), under the leadership of its Spiritual Director, Evangelist Ebuka Obi, is set to commission a landmark project—the first free psychiatric hospital in Nigeria on September 19, 2025 in Aguleri, Anambra state.

The over 7600 million initiative is aimed at restoring dignity, health, and hope to the mentally challenged persons.

The hospital is designed to provide completely free psychiatric care to individuals battling mental illness.

The services include treatment, medication, rehabilitation, accommodation, and welfare at no cost to patients or their families.

The vision behind the project is to create a society where the mentally challenged are no longer abandoned on the streets, but embraced, treated, and empowered to live meaningful lives.

Through this groundbreaking hospital, ZPMO is committed to rescue mentally challenged individuals from the streets, provide professional psychiatric care and medication free of charge and offer safe accommodation and welfare support in a dignified environment.

Others are rehabilitate and

reintegrate patients into society with skills, therapy, and family reunification, fight stigma and raise awareness about mental health within communities as well as combine medical expertise with spiritual care and ensure holistic healing.

This initiative promises to cleanse the streets of Anambra State of neglected mentally ill individuals, reunite broken families with loved ones once thought lost to mental illness, reduce crime, poverty, and homelessness linked to untreated psychiatric conditions, stand as a model of compassion-driven healthcare which inspires similar projects nationwide.

Evangelist Ebuka Obi, described the hospital as “a beacon of hope for the broken, a sanctuary for healing, and a testimony of God's love in action”.

works.

According to him, the emergence of ZPMO, a non-denominational ministry and Ebuka Obi in the country's religious scene, obviously changed the narrative.

situated their headquarters in the big and urban areas of Lagos, Port Harcourt, Abuja and their environs as if Igbo land offended God.

He stated that the good deeds of Zion Ministry and its Spiritual Director must be rewarded at the fullest of time even as he advised self-appointed haters of good things to ask God for forgiveness.

100- Day Fasting & Prayers promises hope for the faithful

The 100 days of Fasting and Prayers of Zion Prayer Movement Outreach (ZPMO) which started on July 5, 2025 promises blessings to Zionites and would-be ones who key into the miracles usually associated with the religious exercise.

Information from the Lagos office of ZPMO confirmed that the annual programme will be rounded up with power-packed crusade at Zion City, Ngor Okpala, Imo state.

VOICE OF ZION confirmed that over 100 million faithful across religious denominations globally, are actively participating in the programme.

Depending on the medical and

spiritual capacity of participants, they are observing fasting combined with fervent prayers between 6 am and 6 pm or at least six hours in the daytime.

Meanwhile, physical developments are on-going at the headquarters of Zion Ministry in Imo state.

We recall that the Committee is, also, mandated by the Ministry to raise funds, competitively select best professional Architectural firm with unique and befitting designs for ZPMO.

Reports from Ngor Okpala headquarters indicated that the new site is already bubbling with construction activities in a bid to beat the set deadline ahead of the historic religious event.

Imo state government which is evidently excited with the development initiatives of Zion Ministry, is expected to beef up security around the headquarters to complement that of ZPMO.

In an extraordinary gesture of generosity, the Spiritual Director who donated 50 bags of rice and three cows for entertainment also gave the workers ₦15

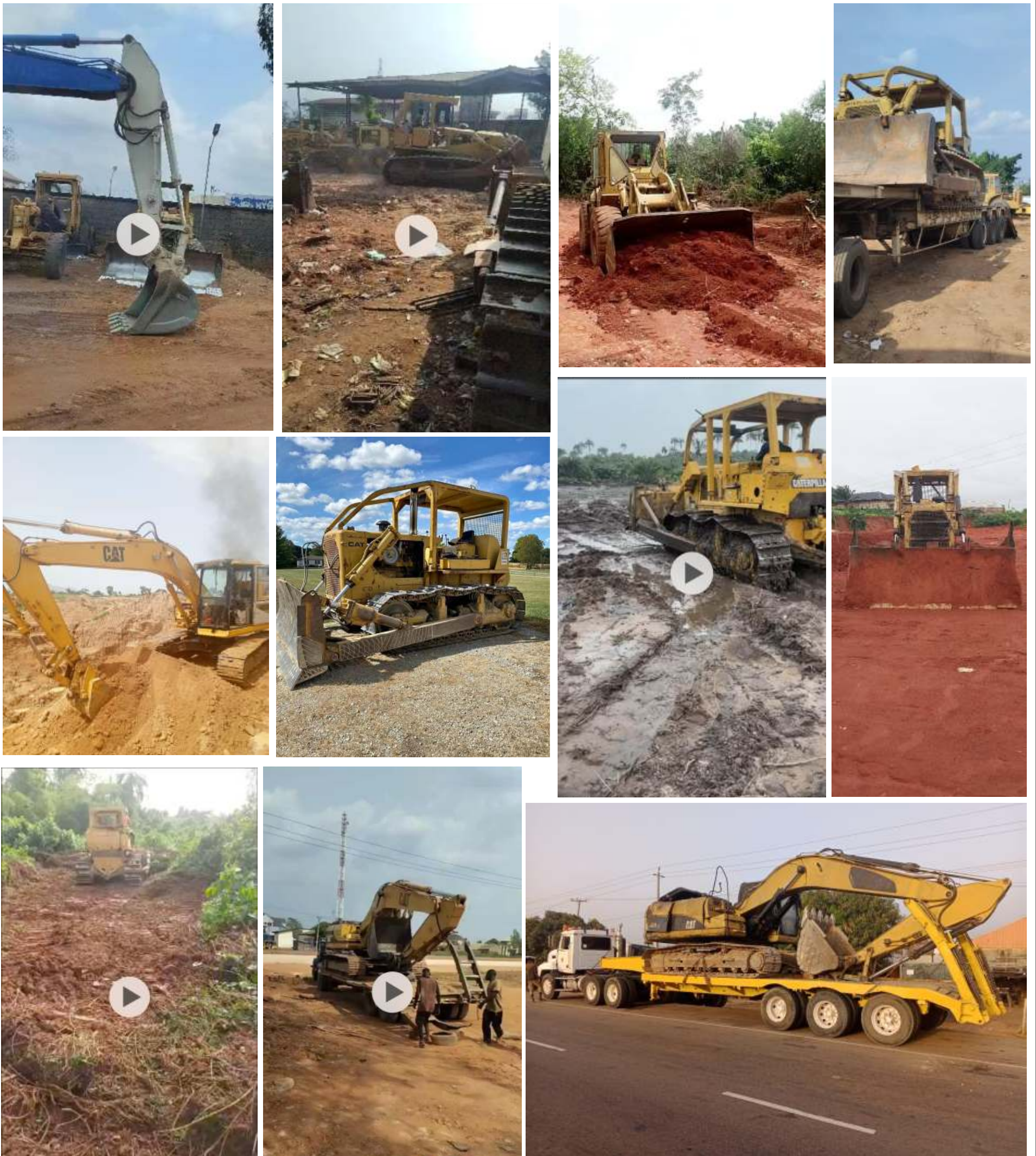
million to be shared among them as seed capital for personal and business development.

Lady Standing Trial for 10-Year Jail Offences Freed after Location by Daddy

An American-based Nigerian lady, Miss Maria Opel, standing trial for allegedly committing three-count felonies that would have sent her to 10 years of imprisonment, was recently freed by the presiding Judge, after being located during the "Night of Open Heaven".

The lady's elated mother, Mrs Viola Opel, married to an Isoko man, from Delta state, shared the stunning testimony during a Sunday service in Lagos.

According to the mother, accompanied by the daughter and husband, "Maria lost control of herself after smoking 'weed' last year".

As a result, she engaged in reckless driving on the streets of America, thereby endangering other people's lives.

She said that such a dangerous action, regarded as a federal case, attracted the attention of three cops whose efforts to stop and arrest her was rebuffed with insults.

The police officers pursued Maria's car, assisted by their colleagues using a helicopter, and were eventually able to stop her.

Even then, she narrated, Maria continued to rain abuses on the cops, and refused to open her car door to be arrested.

The mother added that the car's windows were broken before she was arrested, taken to the psychiatric

hospital and kept in custody for 10 days.

She was arraigned in court to face a three-count charge: fighting with the Police, dangerous driving and resisting

lawful arrest. She was set to go for 10 years imprisonment on conviction.

The mother stated that the case prompted them to embark on fasting and

prayers while they paid a lawyer \$30,000 to plead for reduction of the jail term to a minimum of four years plus community service as Maria was likely to be found guilty as charged.

While the trial was going on, divine help suddenly came through Evangelist Ebuka Obi who prophetically located them during the Night of Open Heaven.

Few days to the judgement date, the prophecy about her release came to pass as the presiding Judge miraculously dismissed the case outrightly, she said.

In her words, "The God of Ebuka Obi timely showed us mercy and compassion and Maria has since gone back to her normal life to the glory of Almighty."



Mother, Son Reunite after Years of Bitter Separation

It was an emotional moment recently when Evangelist Ebuka Obi successfully facilitated the reunion between an American-based Nigerian with his mother after years of separation.

The middle aged man who was at Zion Ministry in Lagos for restoration prayers after suffering setbacks in life was prophetically located by the Spiritual Director, Evangelist Ebuka Obi, and advised him to first reconcile with his mother.

The Evangelist told him that the biological mother's blessing was a

A wife who was estranged from the short-tempered husband was recently reconciled by the Spiritual Director of Zion, Evangelist Ebuka Obi, who also gave them N1 million to begin a new life as a united family.

When their case came up at the "Holy Ghost Court Reloaded", the woman explained that she took a break from the sour relationship, which was already blessed with four children, because of the unromantic lifestyle of the husband who often beat her "like a slave".

However, they were given N500,000 by Evangelist Ebuka Obi and asked to go and renew their relationship within one week and reappear for mediation in the case.

When they returned to the

programme after a week as advised, both recounted their experiences, with their earlier declaration of "I can't stand you" changing to a new commitment of "I can't live without you" to the admiration of the enthusiastic crowd.

Their open demonstration of love was followed by an additional gift of N500,000 to be equally shared by them, while prayers and blessing for the family were offered by Daddy.

He, however, advised the wife to be submissive and respectful to the husband as well as help him overcome his dirty habits.

On the other hand, the man of God asked the husband to control his quick temper, stop beating the wife and be a good father to the family.

Baby Saved From Risky Surgery, Gets N.3m Gift
