Zion Ministry opens N1.25bn free-treatment Psychiatric hospital in Anambra State

*** Gov. Soludo promises State's support, link to national grid**

The Seraphic Homes Foundation, a non-profit charity organization, set up by the Spiritual Director of Zion Prayer Movement Outreach, Evangelist Chukwuebuka Obi, has opened the first free Psychiatric Hospital and Home for the Elderly in Anambra State.

The new N1.25 billion facility was inaugurated by Anambra State Governor, Prof. Chukwuma Soludo, in Aguleri community, Anambra East Local Government Area of the state.

It is designed to provide completely

free psychiatric care to individuals battling mental illnesses.

Evangelist Ebuka Obi said that comprehensive care including diagnosis, treatment, medication, rehabilitation, accommodation, and welfare would be provided to patients all at no cost to them or their families at the Anambra facility.

He explained that the initiative was his childhood vision and that the plan was to touch lives across the country.

"This hospital will start functioning fully from next month (October). We are going to have four vehicles going everywhere in Anambra to pick up mad

persons and bring them here to help them.

"This is my childhood vision. I have travelled to so many parts of the world. You will not see mentally challenged persons roaming the streets in the western world. It is only in this part of the world that this happens", he stated.

Obi said that having completed the project as well as the Orphanage and Elderly People's Home in Mgbirichi, near Owerri, Imo State, his next move would be to Enugu, Ebonyi, Abia, Rivers and other parts of the country.

In his speech, Soludo commended

Over 5m people gather to end ZPMO's fasting & prayers programme

In what has been described as one of the largest Christian gatherings in Nigeria's history, over five million worshippers converged at Ngor Okpala Imo State, from October 10th to 12th, 2025, for the grand finale of Zion Ministry's 100 Days Fasting and Prayer Crusade.

What began on July 5th, 2025, as a divine call to consecration ended in a three-day explosion of miracles, prophetic encounters, and overwhelming praise — a move that has left the entire nation in awe.

It was more than an event — it was a spiritual phenomenon that transformed lives, revived faith, and stirred revival fires across the continents.

Worshippers arrived from Africa, Asia, Europe, North and South America, Australia, and beyond, flooding the quiet

town of Ngor Okpala with songs of praise.

For many, it was not just a closing ceremony; it was a divine pilgrimage to the place where God has continually revealed his glory.

The Build-Up to Glory

In the weeks leading to the closing days, the momentum intensified. Pilgrims began trooping in, long before the official camp opening on October 9th.

The grounds of Zion City transformed into a bustling city of faith — tents rising, canopies stretching as far as the eye could see, and new buildings being raised to accommodate the multitude.

About 60 permanent structures were erected within weeks to house worshippers, while engineers and volunteers worked day and night to ensure every part of Zion City was ready.

The influx, also, brought tremendous

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the evangelist for the project, saying that the government would support it fully.

Based on the foundation's request, the governor promised to construct the road leading to the hospital and also connect it to the national grid.

Soludo told the evangelist that the state government would also support the hospital financially considering that the medical services would be rendered to the patients free of charge.

Meanwhile, Seraphic Homes Foundation revealed that the clinic is

Nigeria's first ever free psychiatric hospital.

It said that this grand opening marked the beginning of a new chapter in the country's healthcare and social support system where love, faith, and compassion complement medical science to transform lives.

"The vision behind the project is to create a society where the mentally challenged are no longer abandoned on the streets, but embraced, treated, rehabilitated and empowered to live meaningful lives", Evangelist added.

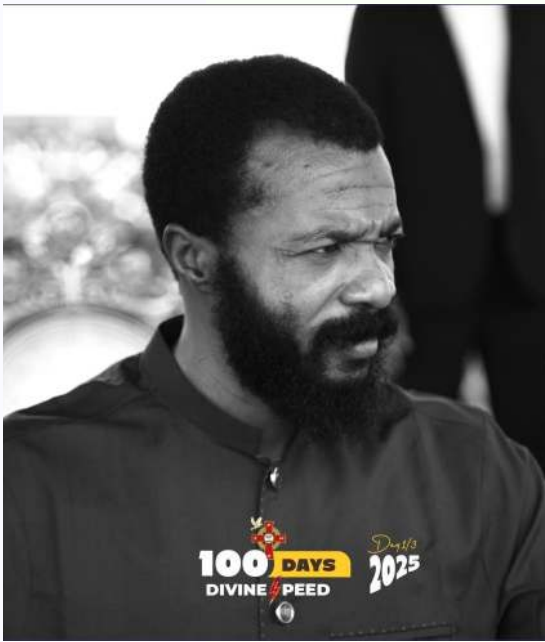

God of Divine Visitation

Divine visitation is a direct encounter or experience with God where an individual receives a revelation, guidance or intervention from the Lord. Who is the divine? It is almighty God, the creator. He is divine because he is omnipotent, omnipresence and omniscience.

Divine visitation can come directly from God or through an angel who brings messages or guidance from God. It is a profound experience where an individual encounters God's presence, power and guidance in a direct and personal way.

TYPES OF DIVINE VISITATION:

- 1) it could be by audible voice, i.e hearing God's voice as recorded in 1 Samuel 3:4-21.
- 2) Dreams and vision: Receiving symbolic or prophetic dreams and visions from God. Genesis 20:1-3.
- 3) Angelic visitation, or, encountering angels who bring message or guidance from God, Matthew 1:18-25
- 4) Prophetic encounter through

receiving a prophetic word or message from a servant of God, 1 Samuel 1:1-18

5) Miraculous Intervention, i.e, experiencing a miraculous event or healing that demonstrates God's power and presence, John 5:1-16

Divine visitation brings healing, deliverance, prosperity, changes situation, rewrites story and destiny, removes barrenness, gives laughter, open doors, miracles and brings repentance.

BIBLICAL examples of divine visitation abound in the Bible.

The first case is in Luke 19:1-4 involving Zaccheus, a short man who couldn't see Jesus Christ through the crowd as Jesus entered Jericho.

So,, he climbed the sycamore tree to get a better view . This encounter led to Jesus Christ calling Zaccheus down from the tree and inviting himself to his home. This resulted in Zaccheus transformation and commitment to change his sinful ways as ruthless tax collector.

Secondly, the man at the pool of Bethesda had been there for 38 years because he was crippled and had no one to throw him into the water (pool) once the angel comes to stir the water.

When Jesus visited, his story changed. He was made whole immediately by spoken words of Jesus Christ without entering the pool, John 5:1-10.

Thirdly, a group of fishermen toiled day and night and caught nothing .But when Jesus Christ visited them, their pathetic story automatically changed, Luke 5:1-11 - "the great catch "

The disciples, at Pentecost, were visited by the Holy Ghost fire and they started speaking in tongues, Act 2:1-47.

Saul was going about killing the Christians but when God arrested him at Damascus, he was converted and later became Paul, Acts 9:1-31.

Paul and Silas were arrested, beaten and imprisoned, but God visited them in confinement and set them free .Even the

keeper of the prison became a believer and got salvation, Acts 16:16-40

In the case of Lazarus, Jesus Christ visited his tomb when it was already late because he was dead and buried since four days .But he was brought back to life.

Beloved, God will visit you for divine turn around in any situation or challenge you are facing because he is an expert in story-changing.

Believe, trust and obey him, no matter how precarious your situation may be.

Ebuka Obi: The Bellwether of compassion in Igboland

In a land where the cries of the vulnerable too often go unanswered, the recent opening of the Seraphic Psychiatric Hospital and Old People's Home in Aguleri, Anambra East by Evangelist Ebuka Obi is nothing short of a watershed moment. It is a gift to Igboland, a mirror held up to the conscience of a people who must now ask: "What have we done?" The Spiritual Director of Zion Prayer Movement Outreach, Ebuka Obi's labours are transforming dreams into brick, compassion into concrete.

Growing up with a prophetic conviction, Evangelist Ebuka Obi has long held a vision: to heal, care and uplift. As he often says, charity begins at home. And in true Igbo fashion, it is home he has not forgotten. His Seraphic Foundation has, over the years, fostered not just spiritual revival, but real, tangible welfare: orphans, widows, indigent students whose fees he picks up, health care for the poor.

What he has done in Aguleri is historic. A 400-bed psychiatric hospital and old persons' home, free of charge. Not just a building, but a statement: mental illness, old age, isolation—none of these will be left to roam the streets like lost sheep. Every market corner, roadside, and bus stop need not be a stage for suffering. He builds where others only preach.

But as the Yoruba proverb says, "When you carry a load on your back, the shadow is always heavier behind you than ahead." Ebuka Obi has not been spared criticism, even from his own Igbo brothers. Some say "why now?", "what politics is this?", "what profit?" Others sidestep his generosity with quiet suspicion or loud cynicism. It is the cleft tongue of jealousy and misbelief: when one rises, the shade grows long.

Yet, what do the critics truly offer? Rhetoric without remedy, complaint without construction, stings without solutions. They are like people who watch a neighbour build a well, but quake at the shadow of its tower. The question must be asked: is it easier to carp at the carpenter, or to lift a hammer oneself?

Why this project matters for Igboland:

*. Human dignity is restored.

For many mentally ill persons in Southeast Nigeria, dignity is a rare commodity. Stigmatized, neglected, sometimes chained, thrown out, left to fend in markets or crash in gutters. To build a facility where treatment is free, medication provided, accommodation guaranteed—that restores the broken mirror, so the image of the afflicted sees compassion rather than contempt.

*. Care for the elderly

In Igbo culture, there is a saying: "Old age and honour bring a crown." Yet many elders in our land have become invisible, abandoned. An old person's home that cares for the elderly is not an indulgence—it is a necessity, a mark of civilization.

*. Mental health, no longer the taboo

Mental wellness—like shame and hidden illness—has been hushed behind doors. One cannot heal what one refuses to see. Ebuka Obi's hospital brings mental health into daylight, declaring: "We see you. We hear your cries. There is help for you."

*. Free service: Charity beyond self

The fact that all services will be free for those who cannot pay shows that this is not vanity or show, but a genuine sacrifice.

*. Model for others to follow

Governor Chukwuma Soludo of Anambra State, himself called the facility a message to Christians: "who are you able to lift up?" This sets a new standard—not just for men of God, but for all who lead: leaders, traditional rulers, the wealthy. If one Igbo son builds a psychiatric hospital, others must

build bridges, schools, clinics, water projects.

Let us taste the critics' honey: they murmur about motives, timing, recognition. Some speak as though Ebuka Obi's deeds are pixie dusts, ready to vanish under scrutiny. They say: "You build, but perhaps there's politics behind it." Others mutter: "This is showmanship." Yet, the hospital stands; the structures raise their heads like beacons. One cannot litigate against bricks and mortar.

"Is there any hidden agenda?", "Why free?", "How sustainable?". If suspicion were a currency, some would be billionaires. But suspicion cannot take patients to the wards; accusation will not cook meals for elders; cynicism does not pay staff wages.

If critics spent half the energy they spend whining on building, perhaps every Igbo community would have such homes. But many prefer being spectators in tragedy rather than participants in solution.

Lion among sheep: In a world that expected Evangelist Ebuka Obi to follow the path of least resistance, he roared. While others drifted in the wind of inaction, he walked the forest, felling trees of apathy and planting seeds of care.

The good Samaritan, but Igboland edition: One does not need to cross borders to do good; sometimes the terrain you tread is your own backyard. Ebuka Obi saw his neighbour in need and healed him.

Pouring water in a leaking calabash: Critics accuse, but unless they plug their own leaks—of ego, of neglect, of pride—no amount of criticism will yield meaningful water.

To his critics, this is not a time to sharpen tongues, but to stretch hands. Do not let Igbo tongue bite Igbo flesh. If you see a man building a hospital, send food, send prayers, send support—not jeer from the gallery. Celebrate where celebration is due.

To the faithful, to the people of Anambra, Imo, Abia and beyond: may this hospital be more than bricks and beds. May it be the birthplace of a new moral economy, where generosity is the standard, not the exception.

Evangelist Ebuka Obi has not merely opened a building. He has yanked open a door of possibility. He has shown that faith need not be silent, that belief must act; that sermons matter less than service. For his sacrifices—time, resources, reputation—Igboland owes him gratitude.

May the Seraphic Psychiatric Hospital and Old People's Home in Aguleri stand for decades, may the elderly find rest, may the mentally afflicted find healing. May the echoes of "thank you" from those halls drown out the whispers of doubt outside. And may every Igbo youth growing up see this act and say: I too will build; I too will care; I too will be the change.

Because after all, a people that forget kindness build walls that imprison their own hearts. But a people that build for the weak unlock their own humanity.
